Heard Mrs. Th. Babita, learned counsel appearing for the applicant and Mr. Lenin Hijam, learned Advocate General assisted by Ms. Sharmila, learned counsel appearing for all the respondents.

Mrs. Th. Babita, learned counsel appearing for the appellant submitted before us that at the time of hearing of the writ petition, a prayer was specifically made before the learned Single Judge for passing an interim order. However, despite the prayer, the learned Single Judge did not passed any interim order. Therefore, the writ petitioner approached this court by filing the present writ appeal challenging the order passed by the learned Single Judge.

On perusal of the impugned order dated 20-04-20223 passed by the learned Single Judge in WP(C) No. 359 of 2023, we do not find any decision being made by the learned Single Judge and accordingly, we are of the considered view that no appeal lies as no decision has been made by the learned Single Judge.

In view of the above, we are not inclined to entertain the present writ appeal and accordingly, the same is hereby dismissed. It is made clear that the petitioner is at liberty to approach the learned Single Judge for passing appropriate interim order, if so advised.
