[1] Heard Mr. Birjit, learned counsel for the applicant and Mr. W. Darakishwor, learned Sr.PCCG for the respondent.

[2] The present application has been filed seeking leave of this Court to travel to Guwahati for a period of 30 days with effect from 30.06.2023 to 29.07.2023 for her medical check-up. Vide OPD record dated 22.06.2023 issued by the Iland Hospital, Imphal, the applicant is referred to higher centre and accordingly, the present application has been filed. It is stated that the applicant is one of the accused in RC 11 (S)/2019-CBI, SCB, KOLKATA and vide order dated 06.11.2019, she was released on bail by this Court along with condition that she shall not leave the station without permission of this Court. It is also mentioned that vide order dated 17.06.2022 in MC(Bail Application) No.4 of 2022, this Court permitted the

applicant to visit Kolkata for her medical check-up. It is prayed that similar relief may be granted to the applicant with the usual conditions.

[3] Mr. W. Darakishwor, learned Sr.PCCG for the CBI has no objection and submits that the applicant may be allowed to visit Guwahati with the usual conditions as imposed by this Court in order dated 17.06.2022.

[4] This Court considered the submissions made by the learned counsels for the parties, perused the application and connected documents.

[5] Accordingly, the application is allowed. The applicant is permitted to visit Guwahati for medical treatment from 30.06.2023 to 29.07.2023 and on returning, she should report to the Court of Ld. Judicial Magistrate First Class, Imphal West-II by filing affidavit of compliance. With these observations, the application is disposed of.
