Heard Mr. S Lodh, learned counsel appearing for the appellant and Ms. R Purkayastha, learned counsel appearing for the respondents.

This is an appeal under Order XLIII Rule 1(d) of the CPC, 1908 challenging the impugned order dated 07.03.2022, delivered in Civil Misc. No. 63 of 2019 arising out of T.S.(DIV) 37 of 2019, whereby the learned District Judge, North Tripura, Dharmanagar has rejected the prayer of the appellant made under Order IX Rule 13 CPC for setting aside the ex-parte judgment and Decree dated 02.07.2019.

The respondent-husband had filed a suit for dissolution of marriage with the appellant. During the proceedings, the evidences were recorded on behalf of the plaintiff-respondent husband and decree has been passed ex-parte dissolving the marriage of the respondent-husband with the wife-appellant.

It is submitted that the first date was fixed for appearance of

the wife-appellant, but that day being a holiday, she couldn't appear.

However, next date was fixed and on that date itself the evidence

was recorded and the decree was passed.

In this appeal, the appellant-wife has taken the plea that she

had not been given reasonable opportunity to defend her case. After

perusal of the order, we find that this is a fit case to remit the matter

to the court of Ld. Judge, Family Court, Dharmanagar, North Tripura

in the interest of justice. Accordingly, the matter is remitted to the

court of Ld. Judge, Family Court, Dharmanagar, North Tripura for

deciding the matter expeditiously.

It is made clear that the Ld. Judge, Family Court shall provide

all opportunities to the wife-appellant to defend her case and she be

given the opportunity to file written statement, if not filed already.

Also the husband-appellant be given liberty to adduce his evidence

afresh.

In terms of the afore-noted, the matter is remitted to the court

of Ld. Family Judge, Dharmanagar, North Tripura.

The appeal stands disposed of.
