## <u>Order</u>

Heard Mr. S. Das, learned counsel appearing for the petitioner who has challenged the impugned order dated 07.06.2023 [Annexure-F to the writ petition] wherein, the DDO, i.e. the respondent no.2 has been deducting Rs.10,000/- per month from the salary of the petitioner in each and every month.

The impugned order dated 07.06.2023 has been passed in pursuance of the order dated 24.01.2014, passed by learned Judicial Magistrate 1<sup>st</sup> Class, West Tripura, Agartala in connection with Case No. CR 91/2023. Learned court had passed an order upon the husband-respondent to pay a sum of Rs.2,00,000/- (Rupees two lakh) to the petitioner within a couple of month being the compensation in addition to other reliefs.

Mr. Das, learned counsel appearing for the petitioner has submitted that the deduction of Rs.10,000/- per month is out of Rs.2,00,000/- as ordered by learned Judicial Magistrate 1<sup>st</sup> Class vide order dated 24.01.2014. It is also submitted by Mr. Das, learned counsel that an appeal was preferred by the respondent-husband before this court, but, that

challenge had been failed and the order passed by learned Judicial Magistrate 1<sup>st</sup> Class was upheld.

In view of this, I do not find any infirmity in the order dated 07.06.2023 passed by the Executive Officer (Admn.), Khumulwng, TTAADC. The learned Judicial Magistrate vide order dated 24.01.2014 had passed the impugned order to pay a sum of Rs.2,00,000/- to the petitioner-wife and till today it has not been paid.

Mr. Das, learned counsel appearing for the petitioner herein has submitted that almost a sum of Rs.50,000/- has already been deducted by the DDO of the petitioner which was paid to the wife-respondent no.4 herein.

I am astonished to see that till today entire amount has not been paid. Accordingly, I direct the petitioner herein to pay the entire remaining balance amount to the wife-respondent no.4 within a period of three weeks from today otherwise proceeding under Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act will be initiated against him.

With the aforesaid order, the instant writ petition stands dismissed. Connected petition if any, shall also stand disposed.

Registry shall supply a copy of this order to the respondent no.4.
