Heard Mr. D. Datta, learned counsel appearing for the petitioner and Mr. D. Sarma, learned Addl. G.A. appearing for the respondents.

The present petition has been filed under Article-226 of the Constitution of India for a direction to the respondent-State to provide a job to the petitioner on compassionate ground under die-in-harness scheme on the death of his father namely, Lt. Nagendra Shil who was a constable under the control of the State respondents and expired on 22.09.2021 while he was in service.

The petitioner has prayed for the following reliefs:

- "a. Admit this petition.
- b. Call for the records from the custody of the respondents.
- c. Issue notice upon the respondents.

AND

And after hearing the parties be please to provide a job to the petitioner on compassionate ground under die in harness scheme on the death of his father namely Nagendra Shil who was a constable under the control of the State respondents who expired on 22.09.2021 during this service."

The case of the petitioner is that the father of the petitioner died on 22.09.2021 and the petitioner has passed his BA degree on 18.04.2022 and according to him he is entitled for a suitable job. In this regard, the petitioner has approached before the respondents and made a request by filing an application on 18.04.2022 and since no action has been taken, a reminder was also given to the concerned respondent on 3rd February, 2023. But, the said request is still pending with the respondents.

In view of the same, without expressing any opinion on merits, the present petition stands disposed of directing the respondents to consider the case of the petitioner in accordance with law within a period of three months from the date of the receipt of the copy of this order.

Accordingly, the present petition stands disposed of. As a sequel, miscellaneous application, pending if any, shall stand closed.
