**ORAL:**

1. Mr. P. Nongbri, learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the case of the petitioner pending before the Registrar of Companies (ROC) has been taken up by the Regional Director (NER), who has taken up the application filed by the petitioner herein under Section 441 of the Companies Act, 2013 for compounding of offence committed under Section 148(6) of the Companies Act, 2013 for the

financial year 2014-15 to 2021-22.

2. The Regional Director, after hearing the parties have accordingly allowed the prayer made therein and had compounded offence as indicated hereinabove.

3. The relevant order dated 04.12.2023 has been produced before this Court today, the same is hereby marked as Annexure-X and placed on record.

4. In view of the said order passed by the Regional Director (NER), the learned counsel has submitted that this matter has become infructuous and could be disposed of as such. It is however submitted that the respondent be directed to take necessary steps on the basis of the said order dated 04.12.2023 to withdraw the complaints made before the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Shillong being C.R. Case No. 350 (S) of 2018.

5. Mr. R. Debnath, learned CGC has submitted that the complaint before the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate as indicated above will be withdrawn forthwith.

6. On consideration of the submission made, this petition is hereby disposed of as infructuous with liberty given to the respondent to

take steps as indicated hereinabove.

7. In view of the above, this petition is accordingly disposed of.
