ORDER

1. Through the medium of the instant petition, the petitioner seeks following reliefs:-

“a) An appropriate writ direction or order in the nature of writ of mandamus commanding upon the respondents to demarcate the land of the petitioner measuring 03 kanals comprising Khasra No. 16, Khata No. 4/14 and Khewat No. 1/1 situated at Village Chak Bana Tehsil Bishnah, Distt. Jammu.

b) An appropriate writ order or direction in the nature of writ of mandamus commanding upon the respondent No. 4 i.e. Tehsildar Jammu South to proceed with, conclude and decide the long pending application under Section 95 of the Land Revenue Act filed by the petitioner measuring 03 kanals comprising Khasra No. 16, Khata No. 4/14 and Khewat No. 1/1 situated at Village Chak Bana Tehsil Bishnah, Distt. Jammu expeditiously and within the time to be phased by this Hon'ble Court”

2. Having regard to the submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner, this Court is of the view that the petition can be disposed of without issuing notice to the other side.

3. Accordingly, the petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to consider the case of the petitioner and pass appropriate

orders preferably without a period of six weeks from the date, a copy of this order is made available to the respondents by the petitioner.

4. Disposed of.
