ORDER

This is an application seeking bail in anticipation of arrest of the petitioner in FIR No. 18/2022 for offence under Section 379 IPC registered with police Station, Janipur, Jammu. The petitioner has been granted ad interim anticipatory bail vide order dated 28.04.2022. Ever since issuance of the notice to the respondent on the said date, the respondent has been seeking time to file reply but the reply has not been filed. On the last date of hearing, last and final opportunity was granted to the respondent for filing reply but the needful has not been done.

In view of the above, the respondent has not brought anything on record to suggest that the petitioner has either misused the concession of bail or he has violated any condition of the bail. Accordingly, interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 28.04.2022 is made absolute subject to the conditions contained in the said order.
