The applicant, who is in custody since 12.12.2022, has approached this Court for grant of regular bail.

The applicant-peon is an accused of siphoning college fund.

It has been submitted by the counsel for the applicant(s) that complete set of FIR along with its enclosure have been annexed with this bail application and there is no suppression on his/her part.

It appears that departmental proceeding has been initiated and the alleged amount has been recovered from the salary & retiral benefits of the applicant.

Innocence has been claimed and participation in the trial has been assured. Investigation is complete. On the above facts, prayer for bail has been made.

On the other hand, learned A.P.P. has opposed the prayer for bail.

Considering the above facts, I am inclined to enlarge the applicant (s) on bail. Accordingly, the applicant(s), above named, is/are directed to be released on bail, on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand only) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned J.M., 1st Class, Jamshedpur, in connection with Golmuri P.S. Case No.13 of 2016 (G.R. No.119 of 2016) on the condition that the applicant(s) will submit self-attested photocopy of his/her/their Aadhaar Card and also submit his/her/their mobile number before the learned court below which he/she/they will always keep active and will not change it during pendency of this case without prior permission of the court.
