03/31.03.2023 The applicant, who is in custody since 31.08.2022, has approached this Court for grant of regular bail in connection with S.T. Case No.634/2022 arising out of Mango (Olidih O.P.) P.S. Case No.265/2022, corresponding to G.R. No.1942/2022.

The applicant has been made accused for the offence under Section 395 of IPC.

It has been submitted by learned counsel for the applicant(s) that complete set of F.I.R. alongwith its enclosure have been annexed with this bail application and there is no suppression on his/her part.

Innocence has been claimed and participation in the trial has been assured. It has been submitted that he has been roped in this case making allegation that he has helped the robbers in escaping. Except confession, there is no material against this applicant. Further, some of the co-accused has already been enlarged on bail. Investigation is complete. On the above facts, prayer for bail has been made.

Learned APP has opposed the prayer for bail of the applicant.

Considering the above facts, I am inclined to enlarge the applicant on bail. Accordingly, the applicant is directed to be released on bail, on his furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Addl. Sessions Judge-II, Jamshedpur in connection with S.T. Case No.634/2022 arising out of Mango (Olidih O.P.) P.S. Case No.265/2022, corresponding to G.R. No.1942/2022, subject to the condition that the applicant will submit self-attested photocopy of his Aadhaar Card and also submit his mobile number before the learned court below which he will always keep active and will not change it during pendency of this case without prior permission of the court.
