04/28.04.2023 The applicant, who is in custody since 09.03.2022, has approached this Court for grant of regular bail in connection with Nagri P.S. Case No.217 of 2021, corresponding to G.R. No.803 of 2022, registered for the offence under Sections 384/ 387 of the Indian Penal Code.

Earlier bail application of this applicant was rejected by this Court vide order dated 30.08.2022 passed in B.A. No.8677 of 2022.

It has been submitted by learned counsel for the applicant(s) that complete set of F.I.R. alongwith its enclosure have been annexed with this bail application and there is no suppression on his/her part.

Innocence of the applicant has been claimed and undertaking has been given for participation in the trial. It has been submitted that charge has already been framed on 07.12.2022 but till date not a single witness has been examined. On the above basis, prayer for bail has been made.

Learned APP has opposed the prayer for bail of the applicant.

Considering the above facts, I am inclined to enlarge the applicant on bail. Accordingly, the applicant is directed to be released on bail, on his furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned J.M., Ranchi in connection with Nagri P.S. Case No.217 of 2021, corresponding to G.R. No.803 of 2022, subject to the condition that one of the bailors will be the father of the applicant and he will also submit self-attested photocopy of his Aadhaar Card and also submit his mobile number before the learned court below which he will always keep active and will not change it during pendency of this case without prior permission of the court.
