The learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is innocent and has not committed any offence whatsoever. The petitioner has been falsely implicated in this case. The learned counsel has further submitted that the petitioner is not named in the FIR. The learned counsel has further submitted that the petitioner has neither been apprehended on the spot nor any article as alleged in the FIR has been recovered from his conscious possession. The learned counsel has further submitted that no TIP has been conducted. The learned counsel has further submitted that the co-accused, namely, Md. Naiyar Alam Ansari @ Pappu Ansari @ Md. Naiyer Alam in BA No. 2958 of 2023 has been granted bail by this Court *vide* order dated 27.04.2023, therefore, he seeks parity. Moreover, the petitioner is in custody since 11.12.2022. Therefore, the petitioner may be granted bail.

Learned Spl.P.P., appearing on behalf of the State, has vehemently opposed the bail application of the petitioner.

Having gone through the records of the case and the arguments advanced by the learned counsel for both the sides, present petitioner, named above, is ordered to be released on bail on executing bail bonds of Rs. 25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand only) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned ACJM, Deoghar in connection with Jasidih P.S. Case No. 482 of 2022, subject to the conditions that the petitioner will submit self-attested photocopy of his Aadhaar Card and also submit his mobile number before the learned Court below which he will always keep active and will not change it during pendency of this case without prior permission of the Court.
