11/ 31.03.2023 A show cause has been filed on behalf of O.P. No. 2, wherein by way of Annexure-A, decision has been taken in view of the writ court order, wherein it has been disclosed that a sum of Rs. 16,70,341/- has already been released in favour of the petitioner, however, with respect to pension and gratuity are concerned, it has been stated that the petitioner comes within the scope of New Pension Scheme.

Mr. Pasari, learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submits that the New Pension Scheme has already been abolished and Old Pension Scheme has been restored by the Government.

In view of the above and considering that the order dated 01.09.2022 has been passed, it transpires that there is substantial compliance of the order of the writ court.

Accordingly, the contempt proceeding is dropped and the petition, is hereby, disposed of. Pending I.A., if any, stands disposed of.

If the petitioner is still aggrieved, he may take recourse, available under the law.
