Heard the learned counsel for the respective sides.

The petitioner apprehends his arrest in connection with Tandwa P.S. Case No. 29 of 2023.

It has been alleged that instead of coal which was loaded from Amrapali, stones and bricks were delivered in the ACC Plant Jhinkpani.

So far as the petitioner is concerned, he is owner of the one of the trucks bearing registration No. JH19A-5253.

It has been submitted by the learned counsel for the petitioner that the vehicle was entrusted to the driver and therefore any illegal act committed by the driver would not reflect on the petitioner.

Learned APP has opposed the prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioner.

Regard being had to the above, I am inclined to grant the privilege of anticipatory bail to the petitioner. Accordingly, the petitioner is directed to surrender before the learned trial court within four weeks from today and on such surrender, he shall be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Chatra in connection with Tandwa P.S. Case No. 29 of 2023, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.

This application stands allowed.
