Petitioners are apprehending their arrest in connection with Adityapur P. S. Case No. 187/2022, registered under Sections 347/ 379/ 420/457/504/506/120B/34 of the Indian Penal Code, pending in the Court of learned C.J.M., Seraikella.

The informant of this case had let her garage to the petitioners for opening their tailoring shop. The petitioners later started claiming the garage to be theirs. The dispute between the parties appears to be of a civil nature.

Learned lawyer for the informant has opposed the prayer for bail of the petitioners but has not disputed the aforesaid facts.

Regard being had to the facts and circumstance of the case; I am inclined to extend the privilege of Anticipatory Bail to them. They are directed to surrender before the court below within two weeks from the date of receipt of copy of this order and learned court below on their surrender shall release them on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 25,000/- (Twenty five Thousand only) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned C.J.M., Seraikella in connection with Adityapur P. S. Case No. 187/2022, Subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
