1. Heard learned counsel for the applicant and learned counsel for the State.
2. The applicant, who is in custody since 16.05.2023, has approached this Court for grant of regular bail in connection with Gumla P.S. Case No.143 of 2023, registered for the offence under Sections 380 of the Indian Penal Code.
3. It appears that the applicant has been made an accused for committing theft in a dwelling house.
4. *It has been submitted by the learned counsel for the applicant that complete set of F.I.R along with its enclosures have been annexed with the present bail application and there is no suppression on his part.*

Innocence of the applicant has been claimed and undertaking has been given for participation in the trial. On the above basis, prayer for bail has been made.

5. Learned counsel for the State has opposed the prayer for bail and it has been submitted that this applicant has one criminal antecedent.

6. Considering the above facts, I am inclined to enlarge the applicant on bail. Accordingly, the applicant is directed to be released on bail, on his furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Gumla in connection with Gumla P.S. Case No.143 of 2023, subject to the condition that one of the bailors will be the close relative of this applicant and this applicant will report once in a month before the concerned police station, till the conclusion of trial and the applicant will also submit self-attested photocopy of his Aadhaar Card and also submit his mobile number before the learned court below which he will always keep active and will not change it during pendency of this case without prior permission of the court.
