**Order No. 05/Dated 31<sup>st</sup> March, 2023**

This writ petition is under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking therein two folds prayer which are as under :-

- (i) For issuance of an appropriate writ/writs, order/orders, direction/directions or a writ particular in nature of mandamus commanding upon the respondents to immediately and forthwith make compassionate appointment of the petitioner

in place of his father who died on 17.03.2012, in harness while he was in service as sweeper, a fourth grade employee in Ganesh Lal Agarwal College, Medininagar, Palamau.

(ii) For issuance of an appropriate writ/writs, order/orders, direction/directions the respondents to pay the amount of G.P.F. and other death cum retiral dues of the deceased employee namely Bhola Ram but the same is also kept pending.

**2.** Mr. Shivam Singh, learned counsel appearing for the respondent Nos. 2 to 4, has submitted that taking into consideration the nature of dispute which pertains to consideration of the case of the writ petitioner for appointment on compassionate ground and for disbursement of the death cum retiral benefits of an employee who was working under the college which is under the control of the University, Respondent No.2 and, as such, the writ petition may be disposed of at this stage for the purpose of taking decision about the claim of the writ petitioner.

**3.** Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner has raised no objection to such submission.

**4.** Considering the same the writ petition is disposed of at this stage by giving liberty to the writ petitioner to file representation referring therein the details of the grievance

regarding both the reliefs sought for in the writ petition so as to submit the same within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of the copy of this order.

**5.** The Vice Chancellor of the Nilamber Pitamber University, Medininagar is directed to consider the said claim and take decision in accordance with law within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of such representation.

Needless to say that in case the decision, if taken in favour of the writ petitioner, the decision so taken will be given effect to within a period of four weeks from the date of decision. However, in case of denial of the claim, the same be communicated to the writ petitioner by passing speaking order within the aforesaid period.

**6.** Accordingly, the instant writ petition stands disposed of.
