Heard the parties.

The petitioner has moved this Court for grant of privilege of bail in connection with S.T. No. 97 of 2023 arising out of Littipara P.S. Case No.15 of 2015 corresponding to G.R. No.302 of 2015 instituted under Sections 367, 368, 371, 323, 341, 504, 506/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submits that the allegation against the petitioner is that the petitioner along with co-accused- Kamala Paharia has kidnapped a minor boy namely Deva Paharia. It is further submitted that the allegations against the petitioner are all false and drawing attention of this Court to Annexure-2 at page no. 18 of the brief which is copy of the certified copy of the joint compromise petition filed by the parties in the court of Judicial Magistrate, 1st Class, Pakur, it is submitted by the learned counsel for the petitioner that the parties have amicably settled their dispute and good relationship has been restored between the parties. It is next submitted that the boy has been recovered. It is further submitted that the petitioner has been in custody since 01.06.2023 as has been mentioned in paragraph no. 11 of the bail application. It is further submitted that the petitioner undertakes to cooperate with the trial of the case. Hence, it is submitted that the petitioner be admitted to bail.

The learned Addl. P.P. opposes the prayer for bail.

Considering the submissions of the counsels and the fact as discussed above, I am inclined to enlarge the above named petitioner on bail. Accordingly, the petitioner is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned A.S.J.-II, Pakur, in connection with S.T. No. 97 of 2023 arising out of Littipara P.S. Case No.15 of 2015 corresponding to G.R. No.302 of 2015 with the condition that the petitioner will cooperate with the trial of the case.
