Heard both sides.

Petitioner is an accused for the offence under sections 363 and 364(A) IPC.

The learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that earlier bail application filed by the petitioner has been rejected by this Court *vide* order dated 05.9.2023 passed in B.A. No. 5996 of 2023 on a particular stage. He further submits that petitioner is moving again after about three months. The learned counsel for the petitioner further reiterated the grounds which he has taken on the last occasion that the petitioner is the close relative of the victim. The petitioner was not the person who had done the kidnapping rather it was two other co-accused persons. He has further submitted that petitioner is in custody since 12.5.2023 and from the date of rejection he has further spent about three months in custody. Therefore, he may be released on bail. He further submits that though the offences under sections 363 and 364A of the Indian Penal Code are not compoundable the matter has been compromised between the parties. The said compromised petition is annexed as Annexure-3 to the petition.

The learned counsel for the State has opposed the bail application reiterating the same grounds which he had taken on the last occasion.

Having heard learned counsels for the parties and in the facts and circumstances of the case, the petitioner, named above, is ordered to be released on bail, on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand Only) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Sahibganj, in connection

with Borio(J) P.S. Case No. 100 of 2023, subject to the conditions that (i) petitioner shall submit self-attested photocopy of his *Aadhar* Card and mobile number before the learned court below which he will always keep active and will not change it during pendency of the case without prior permission of the Court.
