1. This matter is taken up through hybrid mode.

2. Considering the submissions and the materials on record, I am not inclined to interfere in the matter at this stage. It shall be open to the petitioner to surrender before the court below within a period of two weeks and to move for bail. In such event, the prayer for bail shall be considered by the court below on its own merit having due regard to the principle of parity and also take note of the fact that the injury is simple in nature. The bail application shall be disposed of on the same day and in case the petitioner wants to move the higher forum the records shall be transmitted forthwith and the higher forum, shall also consider and dispose of the bail application on the same day on

the ground of parity.

The CRLMC is accordingly disposed of.
