1. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned counsel for the State.

2. It is seen that no show cause in response to the notice under Section 9 of the OPLE Act is filed.

3. Learned counsel for the State submits that since effective statutory remedy is available, the Writ Petition is not maintainable.

4. On balancing the equity inter se, the Writ Petition is disposed of giving liberty to the Petitioner to file a show cause in OPLE Case No.25/2023 pending before the Opposite Party No.3-the Tahasildar, Bhubaneswar within a period of two weeks from the date of receipt/production of copy of this order. If such a show cause is filed within the time stipulated, status quo as on date shall be maintained till disposal of the said OPLE case.
