

- 01. 1. This matter is taken up through hybrid arrangement (virtual/physical) mode.
 - 2. This is the successive journey of this petitioner, who is in custody in connection with Badagada P.S. Case No.101 of 2018 corresponding to G.R. Case No.144 of 2018 pending in the Court of the learned JMFC, Surada for offence punishable under sections 302/201/120(B)/34 of I.P.C. read with section 25 & 27 of the Arms Act and section 3 and 4 of the E.S. Act in filing this application under section 439, Cr.P.C. for his release on bail.
 - 3. Heard learned counsel for the Petitioner and learned counsel for the State.
