- **1.** This is an office reference.
- 2. This Court, vide order dated 12.05.2023 passed in MCRC No. 1565 of 2023, while granting bail to the petitioners, namely, A.K. Singh @ Chandrabhushan Chand and Anurag Singh @ Mukesh Sahi has expressed its trust that the trial Court shall make an earnest endeavor to conclude the trial expeditiously in accordance with law, preferably within a period of six months from today, if there is no legal impediment.
- 3. The learned District & Sessions Judge, Raipur, District Raipur (C.G.), vide its request letter dated 10.11.2023 has requested for extending
