CONSENT TERMS

1. The Respondent Nos. 1 to 4 filed application being M.A.C.P. No. 172 of 2018 under Section 166 of the Motor Vehicles Act 1988 before Motor Accident Claims Tribunal at Mumbai claiming compensation in respect of the death of Mr. Anil Hardas Sahu in a motor vehicular accident.

2. The Claim Petition was allowed vide Judgment and Award dated 6.6.2022, directing the appellant Insurer to pay compensation to the tune of Rs.30,94,000/- inclusive of NFL with interest @ 7% per annum from the date of application i.e.27.11.2017.
3. The Appellant Insurer has preferred aforesaid First Appeal taking exception to the said Judgment and the same is admitted and pending before This Honorable High Court.
4. During the pendency of the aforesaid Appeal, the Appellant and the Respondent Nos.1 & 4 had meetings for negotiations and settlement of dispute once for all wherein the parties have reached to an amicable settlement out of the court.
5. The Appellant has deposited an amount of Rs.41,42,537/- before MACT Mumbai, pursuant to order dated 30/1/2023 in Interim Application No.677/2023.
6. The Respondent Nos. 1 to 4 have agreed that the Appellant Insurance Company shall be allowed to withdraw amount of Rs.7,00,000/- .






7. The Respondent Nos. 1 to 4 shall be allowed to withdraw balance amount of Rs.34,42,537/- along with accrued interest thereon.
8. In view of the above, the impugned Judgment and Award dated 6.6.2022 passed by Motor Accident Claims Tribunal Mumbai in M.A.C.P. No. 172 of 2018 stands modified and the claim of the original Claimants stands fully satisfied. The Claim Application filed by the Respondent/Claimants before the Tribunal as well as the aforesaid First Appeal with Civil Applications therein filed by the present Appellant stands disposed of in terms of the present Consent Terms.
9. That an amount of Rs. 25,000/- deposited under section 173 of the Motor Vehicle Act,1988 at the time of filing Appeal shall be transferred to the Motor Accident Claims Tribunal, Mumbai with accrued interest thereon. The Respondent no.1 to 4 will withdraw the Rs.25,000/- with accrued interest thereon.
10. The Appellants shall be entitled to refund of Court Fees paid in the Honourable High Court as per rules, along with accrued interest thereon.
