2. Learned APP would submit that already police have investigated the matter and filed "A" Summary to the Court of concerned Magistrate. petitioner shall file protest petition before the Magistrate within three weeks from today. On which, the Magistrate shall hear both sides and pass appropriate orders, in accordance with law.
