ORDER:

This Contempt Case has been filed complaining wilful disobedience of the respondents in implementing the orders of this Court dated 08.07.2022 in W.P.No.26022 of 2021.

After notice, the respondents have filed reply affidavit. Along with the reply affidavit, he has also placed the proceedings of the District collector dated 15.11.2022.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that without considering the reports submitted by the Special Deputy Collector and also the Tahsildar, the District Collector has passed orders rejecting the claim of the petitioner stating that the classification of the subject land is poramboke cheruvu. The said observation is contrary to the records and also contrary to the orders of this Court.

Learned Government Pleader appearing for the contemnor has submitted that as directed by this Court the contemnor has passed orders taking into consideration the reports submitted by the Special Deputy Collector and also the Tahsildar. Hence, the contemnor has complied the orders of this Court in toto and there is no violation on the part of the contemnor in implementing the order of this Court.

Considering the said submissions and on perusal of the record, this Court is of the opinion that the respondent have not violated the orders of this Court.

Accordingly, the Contempt Case is closed. No costs.

Miscellaneous petitions pending, if any, in this Contempt Case shall stand closed.
