Aggrieved by the order of transfer, the petitioner has filed the instant petition for grant of the following substantive reliefs:-

- "i. That any appropriate writ/order or direction in the nature of certiorari may kindly be issued and the impugned transfer order and corrigendum dated 28.04.2023 i.e. Annexure P-1 may kindly be quashed and set aside.
- ii. That any appropriate writ/order or direction in the nature of mandamus may kindly be issued and the respondents maybe directed to allow the petitioner to

continue at GSSS Pubowal, District Una, H.P. in the interest

of justice and fair play.

2. A perusal of the record produced by the respondents,

pursuant to the directions passed by this Court, would go to

reveal that the petitioner has been transferred simply on the

basis of D.O. note issued by a minister, who is not concerned

with the department in which the petitioner is working.

Obviously, in such circumstances, the order of transfer cannot

sustain.

3. Accordingly, the present petition is allowed and the

impugned transfer order dated 28.04.2023 (Annexure P-1) is

quashed and set aside. However, since the petitioner has

completed his normal tenure of service at the present place of

posting, therefore, this order shall not come in the way of the

official-respondents, in case, they decide to effect the transfer of

the petitioner in accordance with law.

4. The petition stands disposed of in the aforesaid

terms, so also pending application(s), if any.
