

Reshav alias Subhash vs. State of H.P. & ors.

Heard. Previously, vide order dated 12.12.2023, the applicant had been released on parole for a period of 28 days subject to his furnishing personal bond of Rs. 2,00,000/- with two sureties of the like amount to the satisfaction of the Superintendent, Model Central Jail, Nahan, District Sirmour, H.P.

By virtue of the present application, further extension of parole by two weeks is being sought on account of death of father of the applicant coupled with the fact that the applicant has to perform last rites of his deceased father. The parole previously granted is going to expire on 27.1.2024.

On perusal of the death certificate of the deceased father of the applicant, appended along with present application as Annexure P-2, it is evident that father of the applicant had died on 11.1.2024.

Keeping in view the peculiar facts and circumstances of the case, we deem it appropriate to extend parole, already granted vide order dated 12.12.2023, to the applicant further by 2 weeks commencing from 28.1.2024. Ordered accordingly. However, the aforesaid extension of parole shall be

subject to the same terms and conditions as were imposed
vide order dated 12.12.2023.

Application stands disposed of.
