In view of the decision rendered by this Court in CMPMO No.516 of 2022 titled as Vikas Kumar Jishtu versus Preeti Jishtu on 31.03.2023, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner, on instructions, submits that the petitioner does not want to press the present petition and wants to withdraw the same and sought liberty to assail the order passed, under Section 24 of the Hindu Marriage Act, by way of FAO, under the provisions of Section 19 of the Family Courts Act.

2. It has also been prayed that the time spent in

pursuing the present petition may kindly be excluded while

computing the limitation for filing the FAO.

3. The prayer, so made, has not seriously been

objected to, by the learned counsel appearing for the

respondent.

4. In view of the above, the present petition is

dismissed as withdrawn. The petitioner is at liberty to

assail the order passed, under Section 24 of the Hindu

Marriage Act, as per the provisions of the Family Courts

Act, if so advised.

5. The petitioner is entitled to have the protection

of Section 14 of the Limitation Act if the appeal against the

order passed under Section 24 of the Hindu Marriage Act is

preferred within one month from the date of passing of this

order.
