			Proposed Revision has been filed under Section 25 of the Provincial Small Cause Courts Act, 1887 against the order dated 21.02.2023, passed by learned Judge, Small Causes Court/Vth Additional District Judge, Dehradun in SCC Suit No.55 of 2021. While not striking off the defence of the revisionist-defendant under Order 15 Rule 5 of the Code of Civil Procedure, 1908, learned Trial Court has directed the revisionist-defendant to deposit the arrears of rent from the date of Institution of the said suit i.e. from 27.11.2021 to 28.02.2023. He has also been directed to deposit monthly amount of Rs.30,000/- per month throughout the continuation of the suit. Heard Mr. S.K. Mandal, learned counsel for the revisionist-defendant and Mr. Rishab Ranghar, learned counsel for the revisionist-defendant, requested to dispose of the present revision by granting one month period to the revisionist-defendant to deposit the said amount i.e. Rs.30,000/- per month from 27.11.2021 till today. He further submitted that the revisionist-defendant also undertakes that he shall continue to deposit the rent @ of Rs.30,000/- per month before the Trial Court on or before the 7th of every month. Learned counsel for the respondents agrees and requested to dispose of the present Revision on the

said undertakings. On the said undertakings of the revisionist-defendant, the present Civil Revision (No.48 of 2023) is disposed of accordingly.
