All the offences, for which, the composition has been sought are compoundable under Section 320 of the Cr.P.C..

In that eventuality, since the complainant does not intend to prosecute the present applicant any further, the proceedings of Criminal Case No. 1330 of 2020, State Vs. Yameen Siddiqui, pending consideration before the Court of Addl. Chief Judicial Magistrate, Kashipur, District Udham Singh, would hereby stand dropped in terms of the Compounding Application, and as a consequence thereto, the C482 Application would stand disposed of.
