			(4) This is second bail application moved on behalf of the applicant. Applicant was granted short-term bail application by coordinate Bench of this Court vide order dated 11.11.2022.
			(5) This bail application moved by the applicant seeking regular bail in FIR No. 44 of 2021, under Sections 419, 120-B, 420, 467, 468, 471, 504 & 506 of I.P.C., registered at Police Station Bazpur, District Udham Singh Nagar.
			(6) Mr. Rahul Adhikari, learned counsel for applicant submits that applicant has falsely been implicated in the instant case and he is languishing in jail since 31.08.2021; he further submits that all the co-accused have been granted bail and all the offences, levelled against the applicant, are triable by Magistrate. It is further submitted that FIR is delayed by seven years and a property dispute has been given criminal colour by lodging FIR.
			(7) Learned State Counsel opposed the bail application.

- (8) Considering the submission of learned counsel for the parties and without expressing any opinion as to the final merits of the case, this Court is of the view that applicant deserves bail at this stage.
- (9) The bail application is allowed. Let the applicant, namely, Mahendra Singh be released on bail, on his executing a personal bond and furnishing two reliable sureties, each of like amount, to the satisfaction of Court concerned.
- (10) It is made clear that any observation made by this Court is only for the purpose of disposal of bail application. It shall not be taken into consideration at all in any other proceedings.
