			The parties have participated in the proceedings through video conferencing, who have been identified by their respective counsels.  Learned counsel for the applicants, and including the parties themselves, they have made a statement that the parties have resolved their dispute in terms of the compounding application, as it has been filed in support of the C482 application.  Primarily the set of allegation against the present applicants in the FIR No.32, dated 14.01.2020, was for their involvement in the commission of the offences under sections 406, 504 and 506 of IPC. But, however, later on upon the culmination of the investigation, when the chargesheet was submitted being Chargesheet No.8 of 2021, dated 13.01.2021, the offences under sections 406, 504, 506, 420 and 120B of IPC, were found to have been made out against the present applicants.  Consequently, upon which the cognizance has been taken resulting into the registration of the Criminal Case No.851 of 2021, "State Vs. Jasveer Singh Rana and others". All the offences for which the cognizance has been taken by the court of Judicial Magistrate, Vikasnagar, District Dehradun, are compoundable under section 320 of CrPC.  This Court had interacted with all the

parties, and particularly, the complainant Sri Dharmanand Nainwal, who submits that the alleged duping of his money, as referred to in the FIR, since the entire amount has been remitted to him by the applicants, he doesn't intend to prosecute the applicants, any further, for the offences for which the cognizance has been taken by the court of Judicial Magistrate, Vikasnagar, District Dehradun.

Owing to the aforesaid statement. coupled with the fact that the terms mentioned in the compounding application, which has been duly signed by all the parties, including their counsel verifying the contents of the compounding application. The C482 application would stand closed in terms of the compounding application, and particularly, in the light of the statement made by the respondent no.2, that the entire money, which was due to be paid by the applicants has been remitted. The C482 application would consequently stand disposed of and as a result thereto the proceedings of the Criminal Case No.851 of 2021, "State Vs. Jasveer Singh Rana and others" pending consideration before the court of Judicial Magistrate, Vikasnagar, District Dehradun, would hereby stand closed.
