Proposed Revision has been filed assailing the order dated 19.07.2022, passed by learned Judge, Family Court, Udham Singh Nagar in Case No.199 of 2020, "Gurmeet Singh vs. Karamjeet Kaur", filed under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, by which, learned Judge has allowed the Application, filed by the respondent no.2 under Section 24 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955.
