**HON'BLE MR. JUSTICE ANOOP KUMAR DHAND**

**Order**

**31/07/2023**

1. Instant petition has been filed by the petitioner with the following prayer:

"It is, therefore, most respectfully prayed that:

I) by an appropriate writ order or direction the

respondents be directed to consider the case of the petitioner for appointment / promotion on the post of Assistant Officer (Hospital Services) / redesignated as Officer (OPD and HS).

ii) By further appropriate writ order or direction the respondent be directed to make suitable amendment in their service regulation to provide promotional avenues to the post and he should be considered for higher post in higher pay scale as per his qualifications and experience.

Iii) By further appropriate writ, order or direction the action of the Management in giving charge to unqualified persons of the post of Officer (OPD & HS) may be declared illegal.

iv) Any other order or direction which the Hon'ble Court may consider just and proper in the facts and circumstances of the case, may kindly be passed in favour of the petitioner.

v) Cost of the writ petition be awarded in favour of the petitioner."

2. Perusal of the prayer No.ii indicates that by way of filing this petition the petitioner is seeking directions of this Court to the respondents for making amendment in the service regulation to provide promotional avenues to the petitioner and thereafter his case be considered for promotion on higher post under the higher pay scale as per his qualification and experience.

3. It is well settled proposition of law that this Court has no jurisdiction to issue any directions to the authorities to make amendment in the service regulations.

4. In view of the above, the petition is found to be devoid of merit and the same is hereby dismissed.

5. Stay application and all pending applications, if any, also stand dismissed.
