1. Petitioners have filed this bail application under Section 439 of Cr.P.C.
2. F.I.R. No. 173/2023 was registered at Police Station Singhana, District Jhunjhunu, for offences under Sections 341, 323 and 34 of IPC and during the course of investigation offence under Section 308 IPC has been added.
3. Learned counsel appearing for the petitioners has submitted that petitioners have been falsely involved in this case. It is further contended that injury which is opined as dangerous to life has not been attributed to petitioners. It is further contended that

petitioners are in custody since 05.06.2023 and trial will take considerable time.

4. Learned Public Prosecutor assisted by counsel for the complainant have opposed the bail application.

5. I have considered the contentions.

6. Considering the overall facts and circumstances of the case especially the fact that injury which is opined as dangerous to life has not been attributed to petitioners and also considering the period of custody, I deem it proper to allow the present bail application.

7. This bail application is accordingly allowed and it is directed that accused-petitioners shall be released on bail provided they furnish a personal bond in the sum of Rs.50,000/- (Rupees Fifty Thousand only) together with two sureties in the sum of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand only) each to the satisfaction of the learned Trial Court with the stipulation that they shall appear before that Court and any court to which the matter is transferred, on all subsequent dates of hearing and as and when called upon to do so.
