1. This bail application has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C.
2. F.I.R. No.-**274/2023** was registered at Police Station **Bagru**, District **Jaipur (West)** for the offence/s under Sections 19/54 of Rajasthan Excise Act mentioned therein.
3. It is contended by counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner has falsely been implicated in this case as he has nothing to do with the alleged incident and the alleged offences are triable by the Court of Magistrate. He further submits that one more case is pending against the petitioner. The petitioner is behind the bars since 17.06.2023 and no purpose will be served in keeping him behind the bars. Further detention of the petitioner is not warranted for interrogation and recovery purposes. Trial of the case is likely to take considerable time.



4. Learned Public Prosecutor has opposed the bail application.
5. I have considered the contentions.
6. Considering the contentions put forth by counsel for the petitioner(s) but without making any opinion on the merits and demerits of the case, I deem it proper to allow the bail application.
7. This bail application is, accordingly, allowed and it is directed that accused-petitioner shall be released on bail provided he furnishes a personal bond in the sum of Rs.50,000/- (Rupees Fifty Thousand only) together with two sureties in the sum of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees Twenty five Thousand only) each to the satisfaction of the trial Court with the stipulation that he shall appear before that Court and any Court to which the matter be transferred, on all subsequent dates of hearing and as and when called upon to do so.
