1. This bail application has been filed by petitioner under Section 439 Cr.P.C. in connection with FIR No.09/2023 registered at Police Station Bari, District Dholpur for offence(s) under Sections 143, 307, 504 of IPC.
2. Counsel for petitioner states that allegation of opening the fire is against Aniket @ Ankit and Sirajuddin @ Jamura, who have been released on bail by the Coordinate Bench of this Court; Charge-sheet has been filed and petitioner's case is at better footing than the case of other co-accused. He submits that petitioner is in custody since 23.08.2023, therefore, petitioner be released on bail.
3. Learned Public Prosecutor submits that information to the complainant has already been sent, however, no one has put in

appearance. Further learned Public Prosecutor has also opposed the bail application.

4. Heard learned counsel for petitioner as well as learned public prosecutor and perused the material available on record.

5. Having considered the contention of counsel for petitioner as also the fact that charge-sheet has already been filed and other co-accused namely Aniket @ Ankit and Sirajuddin @ Jamura, have already been released on bail, therefore, on the ground of parity, but without commenting on merits of the case, this Court deems it just and proper to release petitioner on bail.

6. Accordingly, the bail application is allowed and it is ordered that accused-petitioner **Salauddin @ Puddin S/o Chunna** shall be released on bail provided, he furnishes a personal bond in the sum of Rs.50,000/- each with two sureties of Rs.25,000/- to the satisfaction of the learned trial Judge for his appearance before the court concerned on all the dates of hearing as and when called upon to do so.

7. However, in view of pendency of cases against the petitioner, it is made clear that if the petitioner is found involved in similar offence, during bail granted by this Court or breach of this condition is reported or come to the notice of the Court, the same shall be a reason for the trial Court to cancel the bail, granted by this Court.
