**HON'BLE MR. JUSTICE SUDESH BANSAL**

**Order**

**22/12/2023**

1. The instant bail application has been filed by petitioners under Section 439 Cr.P.C. in connection with FIR No.228/2023 registered at Police Station Daulatpura (Jaipur-Ajmer Highway), District Jaipur (West) for offence(s) under Sections 19/54, 54-A of Rajasthan Excise Act.
2. Learned Public Prosecutor submits that information to complainant has already been sent, however no one has put in appearance on behalf of complainant.

3. Counsel for petitioners submits that petitioners has falsely been implicated in the present case; petitioners are in custody since 22.11.2023 and conclusion of trial will take considerable time, therefore, petitioners may be released on bail.
4. Learned Public Prosecutor has opposed the bail application.
5. Having heard learned counsel for petitioners as well as learned Public Prosecutor and perusing the material available on record; considering the nature of offences, which are triable by the Court of Magistrate, no previous antecedents of petitioners, but without commenting on merits of the case, this Court deems it just and proper to release the petitioners on bail.
6. Accordingly, the bail application is allowed and it is ordered that the accused-petitioners (1) **Samim S/o Tahir** and (2) **Mukeem S/o Shri Umar Mohammad** shall be released on bail provided each of them furnishes a personal bond in the sum of Rs.50,000/- with two sureties of Rs.25,000/- each to the satisfaction of the learned trial Judge for their appearance before the court concerned on all the dates of hearing as and when called upon to do so.
