**HON'BLE MR. JUSTICE SUDESH BANSAL**

**Order**

**22/12/2023**

1. Instant bail applications have been filed by petitioners under  
Section 439 Cr.P.C. in connection with FIR No.381/2023 registered

at Police Station Karauli, District Karauli for offences under Sections 457 and 380 IPC.

2. Learned Public Prosecutor submits that information to the complainant has already been sent. However, no one has put in appearance on behalf of the complainant.

3. Counsel for petitioners submits that offences are triable by the Court of Magistrate; charge sheet has been filed and petitioners are in custody since long, conclusion of trial will take its own time, therefore, petitioners be released on bail.

4. Learned Public Prosecutor has opposed the bail applications and states that other cases are also pending against the petitioners.

5. Heard counsel for petitioners and learned Public Prosecutor as well as perused the material available on record.

6. Having considered the nature of offences, which are triable by the Court of Magistrate and the fact that charge sheet has been filed and petitioners are in custody since long, conclusion of trial will take considerable time, but without commenting on merits of the case, this Court deems it just and proper to release the petitioners on bail.

7. Accordingly, the bail applications are allowed and it is ordered that the accused-petitioners (1) **Lakhan S/o Babu Lal**, and (2) **Laliya Urf Laden S/o Hari Pal** shall be released on bail provided each of them furnishes a personal bond in the sum of Rs.50,000/- with two sureties of Rs.25,000/- each to the satisfaction of the learned trial Judge for their appearance before the court concerned on all the dates of hearing as and when called upon to do so.

8. However, in view of pendency of cases against the petitioners, it is made clear that if petitioners are found involved in similar offence, during bail granted by this Court or breach of this condition is reported or come to the notice of the Court, the same shall be a reason for the trial Court to cancel the bail, granted by this Court.
