Heard learned counsel for petitioners, learned State Counsel for opposite party no.2 and Mr. Mohan Singh, learned counsel for opposite party no.3. Notices to opposite party no.1 stand dispensed with.

Petition has been filed under Article 227 of the Constitution of India seeking a direction to court concerned for expeditious disposal of Execution Case No.1 of 2020 instituted by petitioners for implementation of judgment and order dated 15.02.2006 passed in Regular Suit No.251 of 2022 instituted by them.

Learned counsel for petitioners submits that in paragraph 7 of the petition, it has been specifically stated that judgment and decree dated 15.02.2006 has become final and has not been challenged till date due to which the Execution Application requires early disposal.

It is submitted that the judgment debtors have already appeared in the execution proceedings.

In view of submissions advanced by learned counsel for petitioners and upon perusal of material on record, Opposite Party no.1 i.e. Civil Judge (Jr.Div.) Haveli, Faizabad is directed to decide Execution Case No.1 of 2020 (Ram Kewal & others v. State of U.P. & others) expeditiously, preferably within a period

of one year from the date a certified copy of this order is brought on record of the proceedings in case there is no other legal impediment.

Benefit of this order shall be available to petitioners only in case they cooperate in early disposal of the proceedings.

With aforesaid observations, the writ petition stands disposed of.
