- 1. Heard Sri Sunil Kumar, learned counsel for the petitioner, Sri Mohan Singh, learned counsel for the Gaon Sabha, Sri Hemant Pandey, learned standing counsel for the State and perused the record.
- 2. The instant petition has been filed with the following relief:-
- a. Direct the opposite party no.1 i.e. Additional Commissioner (Judicial), Ayodhya Division, Ayodhya to decide the Revision No.C-20230400002009, Nirmal V/s Anil Kumar Verma and others under section 210 of U.P. Revenue Code, 2006, relating to Village- Chorma, Pargana-Barausa, Tehsil- Jaisinghpur, District-Sultanpur, expeditiously within reasonable time as fixed by this Hon'ble court, in the interest of justice.
- b. Any other order, or direction, which this court deem fit and proper under the circumstances of the case in favour of Petitioner be passed in the interest of justice.
- c. Allow the Petition with cost in favour of the Petitioner.
- 3. The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submits that the matter is pending consideration and the same has still not been decided. He added that the interest of justice would subserve if this Hon'ble Court would be pleased to direct the opposite party no. 1 to decide the Revision No.C-202304000002009, Nirmal V/s Anil Kumar Verma and others within a stipulated period of time as may be fixed by this Court.

4. The learned Standing Counsel has no objection to the

contention aforesaid.

5. In view of the aforesaid innocuous prayer, the Additional

Commissioner (Judicial), Ayodhya Division, Ayodhya is hereby

directed to decide the Revision No.C- 202304000002009,

Nirmal V/s Anil Kumar Verma and others under section 210 of

U.P. Revenue Code, 2006, relating to Village- Chorma,

Pargana-Barausa, Tehsil- Jaisinghpur, District-Sultanpur, within

a period of six months, from the date of certified copy is

produced before it, in accordance with law, after affording

opportunity of hearing to all the parties, if there is no legal

impediment.

6. The aforesaid order is subject to cooperation of the petitioner.

7. Accordingly, the instant petition is **disposed of.**
