Let the petitioner, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand)with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Additional Sessions Judge-I-cum-Special Judge POCSO and SC/ST, P.O.A. Act, Jamui/concerned Court below in connection with Lacchuar P.S. Case No. 02 of 2024 subject to condition that:-

7(i) The petitioner shall co-operate in the trial and shall be properly represented on each and every date fixed by the Court through his lawyer or will appear himself.
