2      31-01-2024                      Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and the State.

2. Petitioners apprehend arrest in a case registered for the offences punishable under Sections 323, 341, 326, 308, 379, 354(B), 504 and 506/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

3. As per prosecution case, on the alleged date and time of the occurrence, petitioner Nos. 1 and 2 tried to outrage the modesty of the informant and her daughter and poured hot oil over the leg of the informant. It is further alleged that these petitioners snatched jewelleryes and assaulted the informant and her family members by means of *lathi* as a result of which one



Gulabiya Devi suffered head injury.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that petitioners have falsely been implicated in this case. Injuries allegedly caused by the petitioners are simple in nature.

5. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case and specific accusation levelled against petitioner Nos. 1 and 2, **prayer for anticipatory bail of petitioner Nos. 1 and 2 is refused.** However, the **anticipatory bail with regard to petitioner Nos. 3 and 4 is allowed** and it is ordered that the above named petitioner Nos. 3 and 4 in the event of their arrest/surrender before the court below within a period of six weeks from today, be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail-bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate- 2<sup>nd</sup>, Sherghati, Gaya in connection with Barachatti (Mohanpur) P. S. Case No. 769 of 2023, subject to condition as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
