Heard learned counsel, Mr S I Akand, for the petitioner, Md Mosamaddin Ali @ Md Musamuddin, who has filed this application under Section 482 (1) of the BNSS, 2023, with prayer for pre-arrest bail, as he is apprehending arrest in connection with Sipajhar PS Case No. 64/2024, under Sections 302/34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860

- 2. Heard Mr B Sarma, learned Additional Public Prosecutor, Assam for the respondent State.
- 3. Learned Additional Public Prosecutor has raised serious objection stating that this is a subsequent application. The earlier bail petition was rejected after perusal of the Case Diary, as there are incriminating materials in the Case Diary against the petitioner.
- 4. I have also scrutinized the Case Diary.
- 5. Indeed there are incriminating materials in the Case Diary against the petitioner.
- 6. It appears that investigation may be adversely affected if the petitioner is admitted to bail.
- 7. At this juncture, there appears to be no justified ground to extend the privilege of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner.
- 8. Petition stands rejected at this stage.
- 9. Anticipatory Bail Application stands disposed of.
- 10. Send back the Case Diary.
