ORDER 30.05.2024

O1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid arrangement (video conferencing/physical mode).

Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and learned counsel for the State.

This is an application under section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in connection with G.R. Case No.502 of 2024 arising out of Naikandihi P.S. Case No.99 of 2024 pending in the Court of learned J.M.F.C., Basudevpur for alleged commission of offences under sections 294/323/324/



341/354/379/506/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Perused the first information report annexed to the anticipatory bail application.

Considering the submissions made by the learned counsel for the petitioners that it is a case and a counter case and the offences are triable by Magistrate and some of the co-accused persons have already been granted anticipatory bail by this Court in ABLAPL No.5382 of 2024 vide order dated 28.05.2024 and on hearing learned counsel for the State, I am inclined to release the petitioners on anticipatory bail and accordingly, this Court directs that in the event of arrest of the petitioners in connection with the aforesaid case, they shall be released on bail on bail bond of Rs.10,000/-(rupees ten furnishing thousand) each with two sureties each for the like amount to the satisfaction of the arresting officer with further conditions that they shall make themselves available for interrogation by the I.O. as and when required and they shall not, directly or indirectly, make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to the Investigating Officer.

Violation of any of the above conditions shall entail cancellation of bail.



The ABLAPL is accordingly disposed of.
