Ms. No. 130 Industries & Commerce Department dated 19.04.2005 and despite the orders of this Honorable Court passed in W. P. No. 39701 of 2014 dated 29.12.2014 as illegal, arbitrary and unconstitutional, being in violation of articles 14 and 19 (1) (g) of the Constitution of India and ii. Consequently direct the Respondents not to interfere with the Mining Operations during the validity of the Mining Lease of the Petitioner without following the Law and the procedure contemplated under the Mines and Minerals (Development & Regulation) Act, 1957 and the Rules framed thereunder;
