THIS WRIT PETITION (CIVIL) HAVING COME UP FOR ADMISSION ON 31.07.2024, THE COURT ON THE SAME DAY DELIVERED THE FOLLOWING:

# **JUDGMENT**

The 2<sup>nd</sup> petitioner is suffering from chronic kidney disease, and the 1<sup>st</sup> petitioner has volunteered to donate her organ for the renal transplantation surgery. The petitioners are not near relatives and hence, they have to obtain approval of the 2<sup>nd</sup> respondent. For that purpose, the petitioners approached the 3<sup>rd</sup> respondent Local Level Committee. According to the petitioners, their application is not being accepted by the 3<sup>rd</sup> respondent for want of Certificate of Altruism from the police. Hence, this writ petition.

- 2. I heard the learned counsel for the petitioners and the  $3^{\rm rd}$  respondent.
- 3. The learned counsel for the 3<sup>rd</sup> respondent submits that, so far the petitioners have not submitted the application along with requisite documents. Per contra, the learned counsel for the petitioners asserted that the application and all documents, except the certificate of Altruism, were submitted, but the 3<sup>rd</sup> respondent refused to accept the same.
  - 4. This Court has repeatedly held that the Local Level

Committee cannot insist on production of certificate of Altruism as a condition for processing the application. If at all, it is for the 2<sup>nd</sup> respondent to call for the certificate.

The writ petition is hence disposed of, permitting the petitioners to re-submit the application and directing the  $3^{\rm rd}$  respondent to process the application and forward the same to the  $2^{\rm nd}$  respondent, if all the requisite documents, other than the Certificate of Altruism, are produced. On receipt of the application, the  $2^{\rm nd}$  respondent shall take a decision thereon within two weeks.
