ORDER:

This Criminal Petition is filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (for short 'Cr.P.C.') by the petitioner to quash the order dated 10.01.2020 passed in CrI.M.P.No.198 of 2019 in M.C.No.24 of 2019, on the file of the learned III Additional Family Court at Malkajgiri and also seeking to set aside the *ex parte* order dated 15.05.2019 passed in M.C.No.24 of 2019, on the file of the learned Family Court Judge.

2. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner, learned Additional Public Prosecutor for respondent No.1 -State and perused the record.

3. The learned Family Court Judge allowed the application on the ground that half of the arrears of maintenance had to be paid to the Father and Mother.

4. I do not find any infirmity with the said order passed by the learned Family Court Judge and accordingly, this Criminal Petition is dismissed.
