Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue an order or direction more particularly one in the nature of Writ of MANDAMUS challenging the action of the respondent authorities in not considering Petitioner case for appointment by transfer to the category of Assistant Motor Vehicle Inspector under 10 percent quota meant for the category of Senior Assistant is illegal, arbitrary, discriminatory, violative of Art 14, 16 and 21 of the Constitution of India, and consequently direct the respondent authorities to consider petitioners case for appointment by transfer to the category of Assistant Motor Vehicle Inspector under 10 percent quota meant for Senior Assistants duly disposing of petitioners representation dated 5.1.2017.

**THE HON'BLE SHRI JUSTICE ANIL KUMAR JUKANTI**

**WRIT PETITION No.43065 of 2018**

**ORDER:**

This writ petition is filed seeking following prayer:

"to issue an order or direction more particularly one in the nature of Writ of MANDAMUS challenging the action of the respondent authorities in not considering Petitioner case for appointment by transfer to the category of Assistant Motor Vehicle Inspector under 10% quota meant for the category of Senior Assistant is illegal, arbitrary, discriminatory, violative of Articles 14, 16 and 21 of the Constitution of India and consequently direct the respondent authorities to consider petitioners case for appointment by transfer to the category of Assistant Motor Vehicle Inspector under 10% quota meant for of Senior Assistants duly disposing of petitioners representation dated 05.1.2017 and pass such further order or orders as this Hon'ble Court may deems fit and proper in the circumstances of the case"

2. Matter pertains to the year 2018, on 28.11.2018, writ petition was admitted. On 19.08.2023, 01.11.2023 and 15.11.2023, matter was adjourned. On 21.08.2024, there was no representation on behalf of petitioner, writ petition was posted under the caption 'for dismissal'. On 28.08.2024,

a request was made by counsel for petitioner, matter was posted to 30.08.2024. Today i.e., on 30.08.2024, when the matter is called, there is no representation on behalf of petitioner in spite of matter being listed under caption 'for dismissal'. Hence, this Court is constrained to deal the matter on merits.

3. Brief facts:

It is the case of petitioner that he made a representation on 05.01.2017, pursuant to the directions of A.P. Administrative Tribunal (for short 'Tribunal') in O.A.1016 of 2011 and respondents have not taken any action and hence, the writ petition.

4. It is the specific case of petitioner that petitioner be considered for appointment to the category of Assistant Motor Vehicle Inspector(s) from the category of Senior Assistant under 10% quota meant for Senior Assistant category by transfer. It is further the case that though petitioner has

obtained Diploma in Automobile Engineering Certificate from the Vinayaka Missions University, Salem, Tamilnadu, his case is not being considered. It is also the case of petitioner that similarly situated persons have been considered.

5. Issue pertains to non-consideration of representation(s) of petitioner dated 30.10.2014 and 05.01.2017 for appointment to the category of Assistant Motor Vehicle Inspector(s) under 10% quota meant for category of Senior Assistant by transfer. This Court deems it appropriate that interest of justice would be met, if respondents authorities are directed to dispose of the representations dated 30.10.2014 and 05.01.2017. Before disposal of representation, petitioner be intimated/communicated with respect to the date of hearing of representations. Thereupon, petitioner shall present his case. Respondent authorities are directed to dispose of the representation within a period of one (01) month from the date of receipt of a copy of this order by passing appropriate orders.

6. With the above directions, Writ Petition is disposed of.  
No order as to costs.

Miscellaneous petitions, if any, pending, shall stand dismissed.
